

# KOROKORO VALLEY, BELMONT REGIONAL PARK, HUTT VALLEY

**Map:** Topo50-BQ32 Lower Hutt

**Grid reference:** 56353710 at confluence of true left and true right branches

**Catchment:** Korokoro Stream

**Altitude range of field trip:** 5 m to 200 m

**Landform:** valley

**Geology:** Triassic – Jurassic greywackes and argillites (undifferentiated), including semischists, (per NZ Soil Bureau Map 106/1).

**Aspect:** true left branch: north-west and south-east; below forks: east and west;

**Rainfall:** long-term average for Hutt Valley – 1150 mm p.a.

**Ecological District:** Wellington Ecological District 39.01

**Forest classification:** regenerating and mature coastal forest

**Tenure:** Hutt City Council

**Management:** Greater Wellington Regional Council

**Status:** Scenic Reserve

These lists were prepared by Wellington Botanical Society during a 6-hour visit on 4-8-2007. During this visit, a document “Korokoro Reservoir and Scenic Reserve - Based on lists prepared between 1989 and 2002”, by unknown author(s), was used as a template.

These lists were added to by Wellington Botanical Society during a 4-hour visit on 4-2-2012.

**Route 4-8-2007:** Oakleigh St, Maungaraki, entrance – northeast on track for c. 1 km to track junction - track to Korokoro Reservoir - Korokoro Forks – Cornish St, Petone.

**Route 4-2-2012:** Oakleigh Street, Maungaraki, entrance - down track to Korokoro Dam, then up former track up past a large redwood, and through an area of felled pines, to the Oakleigh Street entrance.

## OBSERVATIONS: 4-2-2012

- *Drymoanthus adversus* was seen on two tawa.
- The site is subject to possum control by Greater Wellington Regional Council (GWRC).
- The weed fern, *Pteris cretica*, was seen below a bridge, near bait station 08. Specimens were collected for GWRC and Te Papa.
- In the felled pine forest on the upper part of the former track, the following species are establishing: Indigenous species: māpou, māhoe, rangiora, ponga, mamaku, kohuhu, wineberry, hangehange, *Coprosma lucida*, *C. robusta*, etc. Adventive species: gorse, Himalayan honeysuckle, holly-leaved senecio, etc.
- A tomtit was heard, the third record in the park in the last four years (N. McArthur, GWRC, pers.comm.).
